

Chinese carrier Lucky Air had its inaugural Kunming – Cebu flight last June 1. The flight arrived in Cebu at 1815H and was welcomed with the ceremonial water cannon salute. All arriving and departing passengers were welcomed by GMCAC, Department of Tourism Region 7 and Lucky Air executives. The flight crew graced the cake cutting ceremony to officially celebrate the event.

Lucky Air operates the route on a 3x weekly schedule. Kunming is Cebu Airport's 5th destination in mainland China after Chengdu, Xiamen, Fuzhou, and Chongqing.

China Eastern holds Cebu product launch

China Eastern Airlines (MU) held a product launch last June 1 at Radisson Blu Hotel Cebu, to formally announce its new routes in the Philippines. As the airline celebrates its 60th year this 2017, it will launch (4) new routes in the Philippines: Cebu – Guangzhou – Cebu (CAN), Shanghai – Cebu – Shanghai (PVG), Kunming – Manila – Kunming (KMG) and Clark – Shanghai – Clark (PVG).




"Cebu is one of the top tourist destinations here in the Philippines and we're excited to contribute in bringing more visitors through our flights. Also, for Filipinos here in the Visayas and Mindanao, they can now take the Cebu – Shanghai flight and connect to our wide network of destinations," said China Eastern Airlines General Manager Channe Chen.

The Cebu – Guangzhou route will commence on July 13 on a twice weekly service, while daily Cebu – Shanghai flights will start on October 18 later this year. Both routes will utilize B737 aircraft.

China Eastern Airlines currently operates Cebu – Chengdu thrice weekly.



Network Updates

5J adds MBT, MNL cap

Cebu Pacific through its wholly-owned subsidiary Cebgo will fly Cebu – Masbate (MBT) effective July 26. Masbate is Cebu Pacific's 28th destination from Cebu, increasing Cebu Airport's total domestic network to 29 destinations.

Starting July, Cebu Pacific will utilize its A330 on the Manila – Cebu route 3x daily. The upgrade will add 256 seats per flight or 59% more capacity.



HOW TO GET THERE: Take a (20-minute ferry ride) from the port at Punta Ngayo, Mactan (beside Movenpick Hotel). There are trips every 30 minutes and cost Php 15.

- ACTIVITIES:**
1. Go island hopping in Olango, Sulpa, Gilutungan, Nalusuan and Caohagan islands.
 2. Visit the wildlife sanctuary where migratory birds make their stop during the winter months.
 3. Go snorkeling or diving in the various marine sanctuaries scattered around the islands.

INTERNATIONAL ROUTE MAP


