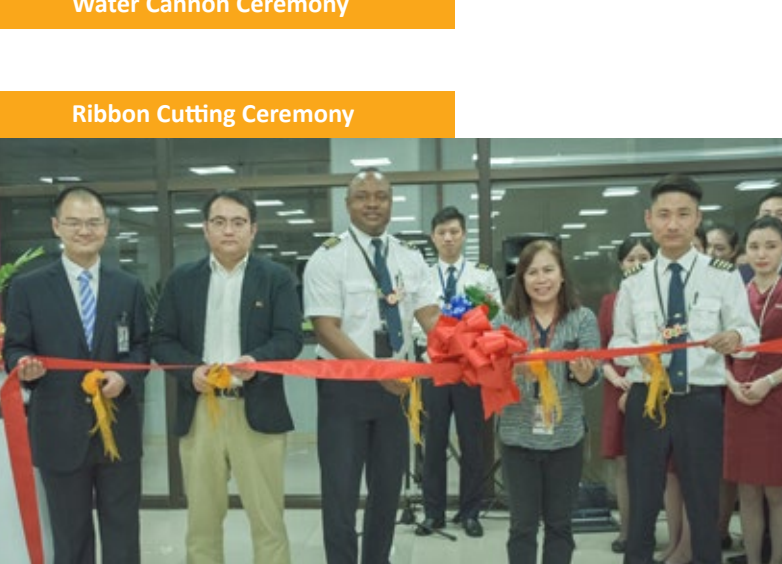


Two new Chinese airlines welcomed in Cebu

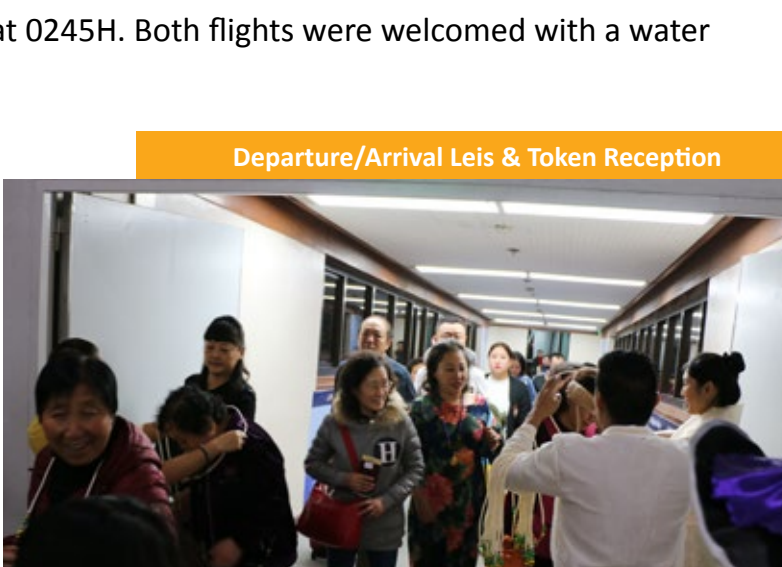

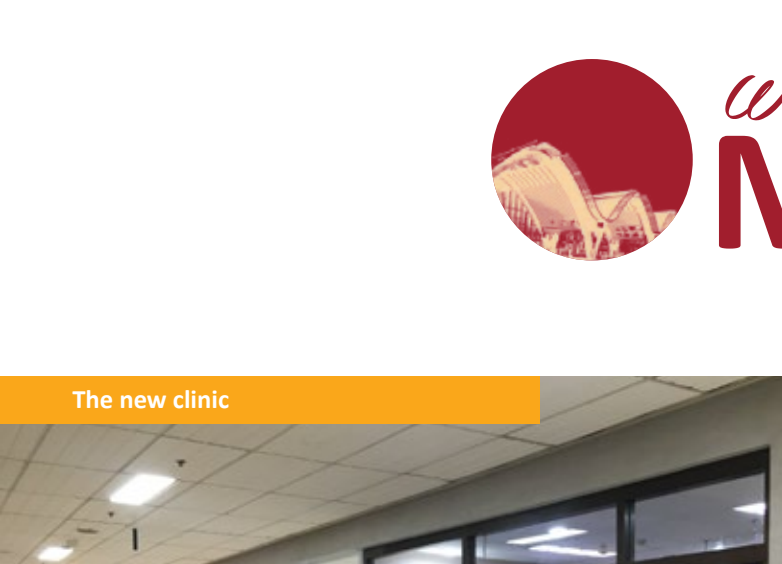


Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

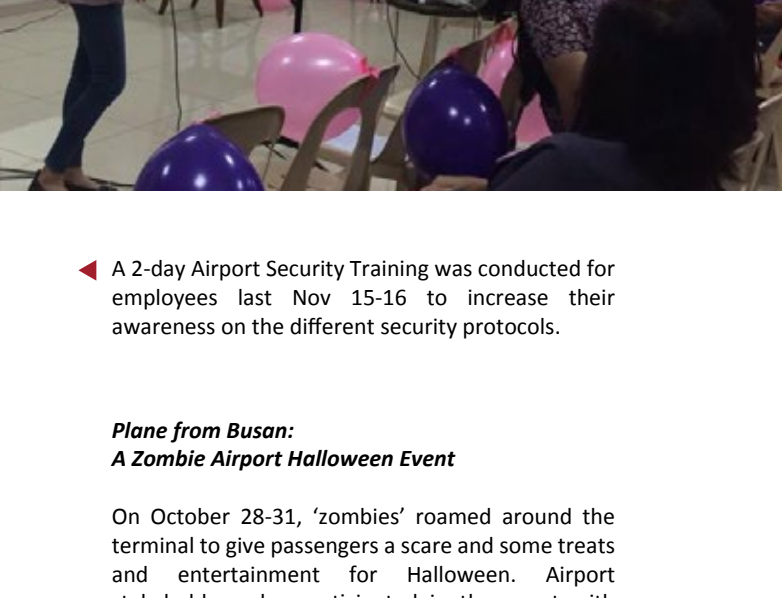

The airport medical clinic has been relocated to the Arrival Hall beside the Transfer Desk.

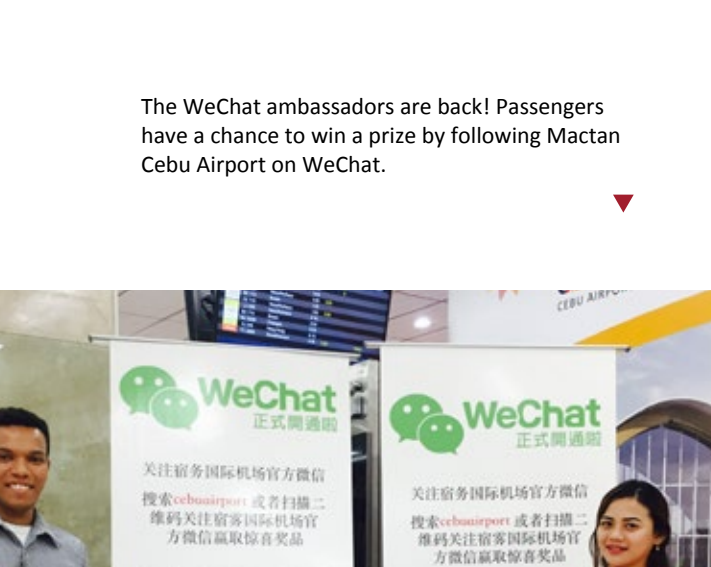
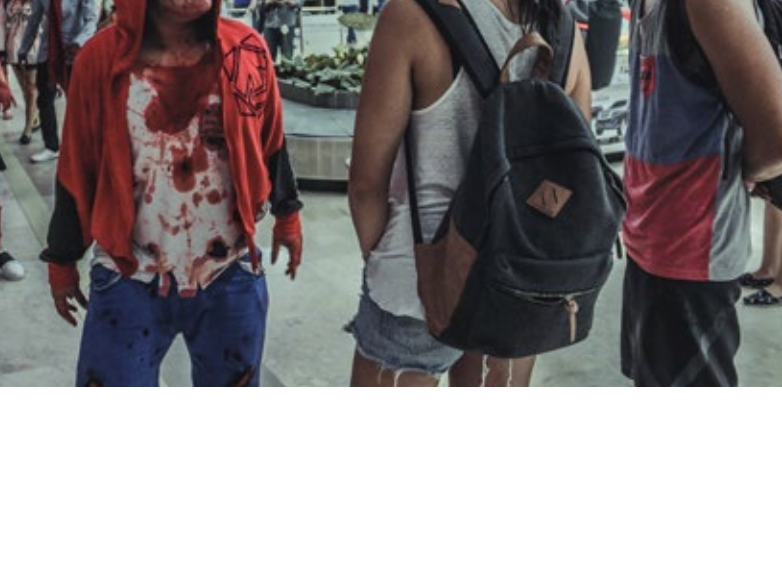
In line with Breast Cancer Awareness month, GMCAC employees had the opportunity to join forums and lectures and get free consultation and examination.

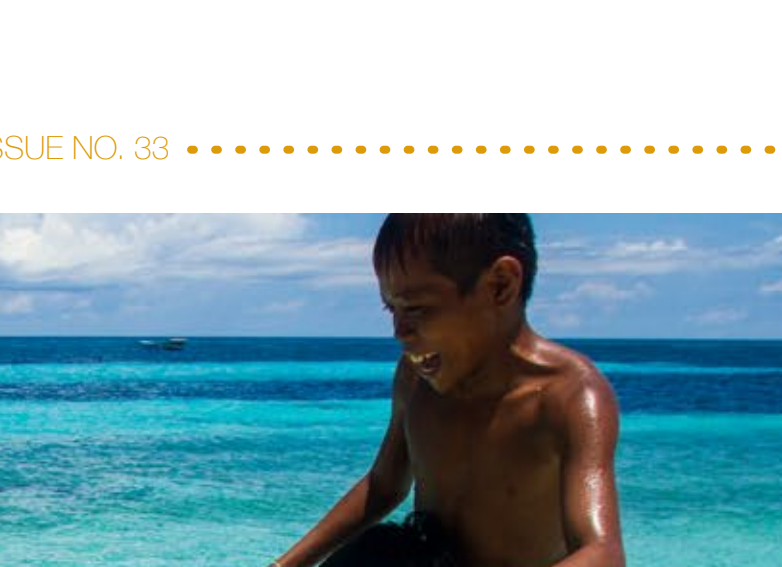

Cebu is 2nd Best Island in the World

Once again, Cebu has been voted as one of the best islands in the world in Conde Nast Traveler's Readers' Choice Awards. Cebu and the Visayan Islands ranked second, being noted for its beaches. CNT describes Cebu: 'not as wild as Phuket in Thailand, Cebu city is more personal, with plenty of up-and-coming restaurants and shopping'.

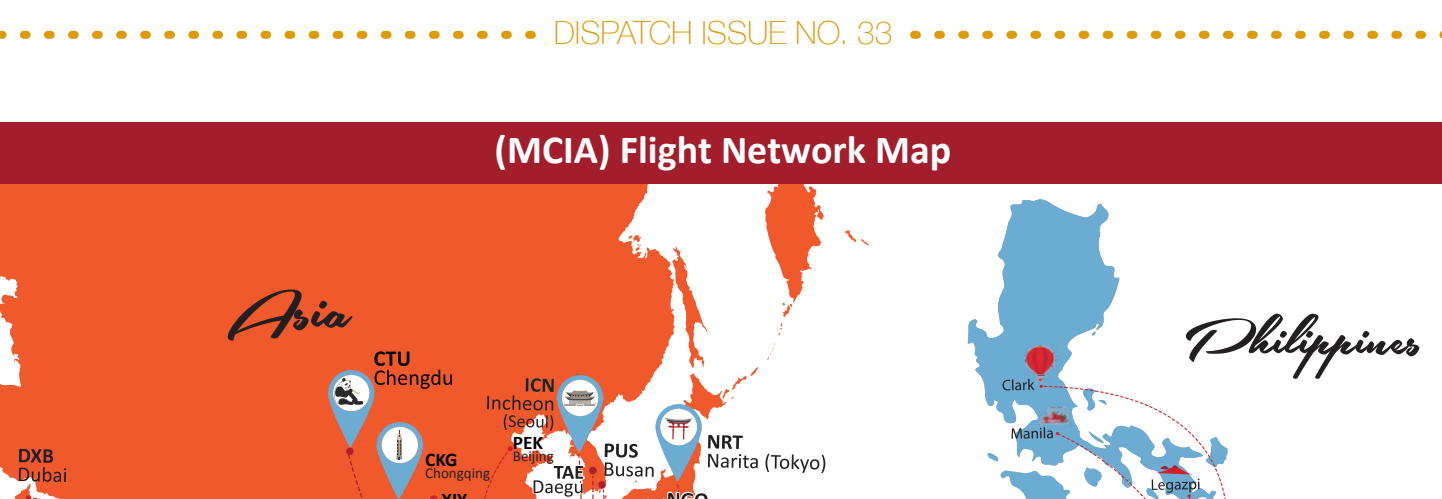

New 'visa upon arrival' for Chinese tourists

The Department of Justice has allowed the issuance of visa upon arrival for Chinese nationals entering Cebu, Manila, Clark and Kalibo. In the new scheme, Chinese nationals, through their top operators, may apply for their visa at least 10 days before arrival for an initial stay of 30 days. Applicants should have valid passports and return tickets. Each of them shall be charged a visa fee of US\$25 and PHP10 legal research fee. The Immigration Commissioner shall issue an order approving the visa and this shall be presented by the Chinese passengers to immigration officers upon their arrival in the country.

- HOW TO GET THERE:**
How to get there: Ride a bus or shuttle van bound for Toledo at the South Bus terminal; travel time 1-2 hours.
- WHAT TO DO:**
1. Rock climb – Cantabaco and Poog, with many routes on the limestone cliffs. The two most famous crags are in Cantabaco and Poog, with bolted several for both beginners and experts.
 2. Hike – Tagaytay Hill has gentle slopes with a nice view of Malubog Lake from the summit.
 3. Explore Malubog lake and falls
 4. Visit the Capilla Santa Ana museum, famous for its maze-like garden
