
## Two new Chinese airlines welcomed in Cebu

Philippines, and Mr. Johann Zhang, HO Financial Comptroller, graced the cake cutting and ribbon cutting ceremonies.





New 'visa upon arrival' for Chinese tourists

The Department of Justice has allowed the issuance of visa upon arrival for Chinese nationals entering Cebu, Manila, Clark and Kalibo. In the new scheme, Chinese nationals, through their tour operators, may apply for their visa at least 10 days before arrival for an initial stay of 30 days. Applicants should have valid passports and return tickets. Each of them shall be charged a visa fee of US\$25 and PHP10 legal research fee. The Immigration Commissioner shall issue an order approving the visa and this shall be presented by the Chinese passengers to immigration officers upon their arrival in the country.
